About the show:

PLOT17 tours in a converted horsebox van called IVY, which can set up directly in your playground. The performance is based on the idea of an 80's hip-hop block party and is a series of tracks written and performed by Kenny Baraka with live DJ-ing. The theme of the show is to encourage the audience to connect more with nature and the environment and enhance children's literacy.



More info:

- ▶ The horsebox contains everything we need for the show. We just need access to a 13amp socket.
- ▶ The van measures 2.3m wide, 5.6 m long and 3m tall – please check that any access routes can accommodate this.
- ▶ The show takes around 1.5 - 2 hours to set up and just over an hour to take down. We build a stage from the horsebox ramp, fix up a canopy and plug in sound equipment and TVs for visuals. We need a space approximately 7m long and 6m deep to park IVY in and be able to access what we need to on the van.
- ▶ The show uses amplified music so there will be some noise that might travel to classes not involved in the show, just to be aware!
- ▶ This relaxed performance lasts for about 40 minutes and is interactive, we encourage the audience to join in with call and response and moving to the music, and welcome different styles of engagement. There are also TV screens which show some visuals.
- ▶ Age Guidance: 7 - 11yrs, Key Stage 2, Year 3 - Year 6
